Interpreter Unit Simplified Operation Manual



(Microphone operation)

- ① Select the language to be interpreted displayed on the LCD with the "Channel Select"
- 2 The "Microphone" is used to turn the microphone ON/OFF
- 3 Press the "Mute" to temporally turn off the microphone

[Adjustment of the listening voice]

- 4 The headphone volume can be adjusted (Alarm for hearing protection is available. Select the model when connecting headphones)
- ⑤ The speaker volume can be adjusted. (The speaker is turned off when the microphone is on)
- 6 Adjust the sound quality of the audio to be listened to. (Top knob: high audio, Bottom knob: low audio)
- Select the audio to be heard on the speakers.

(Selecting the audio for listening)

- Select this option to listen to the floor audio (venue audio) only
- 9 To listen to the interpreter audio and floor audio, select the language allocated to the channel selector (Used during relay interpreting)

(Other)

- 10 This is set to switch between the camera image and content image output from the interpreter unit HDMI connector
- ① Assignable buttons for interpreting support functions such as slow-speak, replay, and video selection
