WIVIA is a wireless projector for your computer screen.
Wireless projection system for projection.

*This is the WIVIA screen displayed on the projector (example).



- (1) Name of WIVIA.

- Passcode (confirmation code) for connecting to wivia(The display is an example).


*This screen will not be visible during the presentation,

Projection Procedure (1) Enter wivia's IP in your browser (Chrome or Edge).



Step 1: When connecting for the first time, a different warning screen will appear for each web browser; for the Chrome browser, click "Go to site", "Advanced", and then "Access (IP address)".

Projection Procedure 2) Click "Start" on the displayed screen. Projection Procedure 3) Enter the passcode and click "Start Presentation."




Projection Procedure (4) Select the screen you wish to display and share.



*Up to 4 people can present at the same time.
(A single wivia can project up to four separate screens.)

Projection Procedure (5) Presentations are made using a computer.



Projection Procedure (6): Release sharing.




Step 5: Click "Stop Sharing" or close the browser to cancel screen sharing
